 - _____ Does the information on the paper match the information in the system (title, authors)?
 - ____ Does this paper show any indications of commercialism?
 - _____ Is the grammar acceptable?
 - _____ Is the writing clear and to the point?
 - _____ Are the graphics clear and easily read?
 - Is the paper length appropriate? Typically papers are 6-10 pages.
- 2. Abstract
 - ____ Is the abstract a brief description of what is contained in the paper?
 - Is the abstract the same or very similar to what was submitted to the committee?
- 3. Introduction
 - ____ Does the introduction explain the setting or background of the paper?
 - _____ Does the introduction set the stage for the body of the paper?
- 4. Body
 - ____ Does the body of the paper tell the story?
 - _____ Is the body broken into several subsections? Examples below:
 - Design, Goetechnical Conditions, Contracting, Construction, Challenges/Lessons Learned
 - Hypothesis, Testing Mechanisms/Research Studies, Results, Analysis
 - Description of Method, Applicable Soil Conditions, Challenging Applications, Case Histories
- 5. Conclusion
 - _____ Does the conclusion explain why the author wrote the paper?
 - ____ Does the conclusion explain everything clearly?
- 6. References

Are the references standardized?
